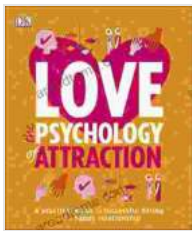

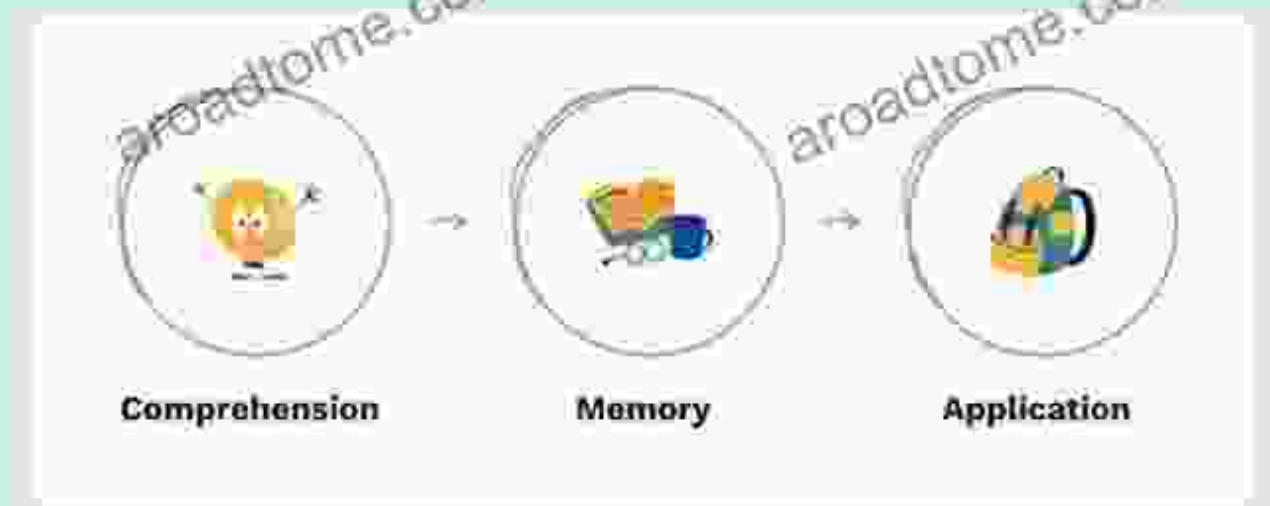

- ▶ Rather, similarity is a powerful predictor of attraction
- ▶ Classic study by Newcomb (1961)
- ▶ Link between similarity and attraction is quite robust:
 - Opinions and personality
 - Interpersonal style
 - Interests and experiences

The Influence of Social Context

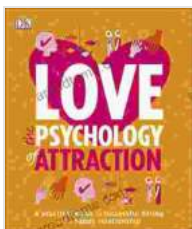
